

Frequently Asked Questions

Distribution

- Your initial order may be adjusted by Council prior to distribution.
- Distribution will be Friday, March 2th Saturday March 3. at a location in your district or the Scout Office. Contact your district executive for time and location details
- Those units helping with counting and packing can do an early pickup on February 28th after packaging is complete.
- You will receive a sale kit for each active Scout you indicated when you placed your order
 - o A sales kit includes a card stock promotional envelope with 20 cards already placed in the pocket of the envelope
- Any additional cards ordered are bundled in sets of 5, 10 or 20 based on how many additional cards were ordered
- Only pre-ordered Cards will be available at time of initial distribution
- All orders must be counted and receipted at time of distribution.

Need More Cards?

- We will have a limited availability of additional cards
- They can be checked out through your district executive or the Sacramento Service Center
- In order to receive additional cards you must:
 - o Make payment of at least ½ of your initial order (i.e.: 100 cards were initially ordered you must make a \$125 payment)
 - o Do not turn in less than your original order upon settlement of your order

Prizes

- **Sell 20 and get a co-branded River Cats & Boy Scout Hat and Game ticket**
 - o Camp Master or parent may enter name, address, phone number and e-mail address on the Golden Empire Council website by clicking on the "I Sold 20" icon on the left side of www.gec-bsa.org; or by registering directly on this website: <http://www.gec-bsa.doubleknot.com/event/i-sold-20-camp-card-promotion/1887615>
 - o Hat may be picked up by the Unit Camo Card Coordinator at the Sacramento Service Center or at your district's April or May Roundtable; Hats will not be available until April 1.
 - o In some cases, your district executive may deliver hats to a Pack or Troop meeting
- **Weekly Free Camp drawings**
 - o Camp Master or parent may enter name, address, phone number and e-mail address on the Golden Empire Council website by clicking on the "I Sold 20" icon on the left side of www.gec-bsa.org (you do not have to enter the name twice)
 - o Drawings will be held each Monday at 9am starting March 12 and ending April 30
 - o Free Camp certificate will be delivered to the Scout
 - o Certificate must be used in 2018 at a Golden Empire Council operated camp and is non-transferable

- Cub Scouts may choose between Day/Twilight Camp or Resident Camp (resident camp will include one adult)
 - Boy Scout will be able to choose between Golden Empire Council Boy Scout Camp Lassen or Camp Winton
 - You only need to register once to be included in all subsequent drawings
- **Above and Beyond Prizes**
- Every Cub Scout who sells 100 or more cards may choose between the following prizes based on the number of cards sold (Scout can only choose 1 prize):
 - Day/Twilight Camp (100 cards)
 - Cub Resident Camp with adult (250 cards)
 - iPod Touch (500 cards)
 - iPad A9 (1,000 cards)
 - Every Boy Scout who sells 250 or more cards may choose between the following prizes based on the number of cards sold (Scout can only choose 1 prize):
 - Boy Scout Resident Camp (250 cards)
 - iPod Touch (500 cards)
 - iPad A9 (1,000 cards)
 - Prizes are in addition to the commission the Unit earns
 - Camp Prizes are non-transferable, have no cash value and may only be redeemed at a Golden Empire Council operated camp in 2018
 - Prize forms are available to download at <http://www.gec-bsa.org/promotions/campcards>; these may be submitted at the time you settle your account but no later than May 18th

Settlement of Your Account

- Payment is due by May 18th and may be settled at the Sacramento Service Center or with your District Executive at your May Roundtable or by appointment
- You must pay for any sold or lost cards minus your Unit's commission (\$2.50 for each unreturned card)
- You may return any unsold cards in new condition (must have all 4 break-off tabs still attached)
- No cards will be accepted for return after May 18th

How Should We Spend Our Commission?

- Your Scouting Unit may choose to spend your commission any way your committee decides; however, our recommendation is to use your commission to offset the cost of camp for your families
