District Award of Merit

What is the District Award of Merit?

The District Award of Merit (Silver Bear) is the highest recognition a Scouting District can bestow upon an individual. The award is presented to a registered volunteer Scouters for noteworthy service to youth. The requirements for the award are:

- Candidates for the award must be a registered volunteer Scout leader.
- They must have rendered noteworthy service to youth in Scouting, outside Scouting, or both.
- Consideration must be given to the nominee’s Scouting position and the corresponding opportunity to render outstanding service beyond the expectations of that Scouting position.
- The nominee’s attitude toward and cooperation with the district and/or council is to be taken into consideration.
- A minimum of five years of accumulated service to youth will be considered.
- Only use this form. Additional documentation will be discarded.
- **Nominations must be received by March's Roundtable.**
