

Frequently Asked Questions

Distribution

- Units who participate in camp card counting will be able to take their cards that day
- Distribution will be Friday after the camp cards arrive at a location in your district. Contact your district executive for time and location details
- You will receive a sale kit for each active Scout you indicated when you placed your order
 - o A sales kit includes a card stock promotional envelope with 20 cards per selling Scout
- Any additional cards that we ordered are bundled in sets of 20 based on how many additional cards were ordered
- Additional cards will not be available at time of distribution

Need More Cards?

- We will have a limited availability of additional cards
- They can be checked out through your district executive or the Sacramento Service Center
- In order to receive additional cards you must:
 - o Make payment of at least ½ of your initial order (ie: 100 cards were initially ordered you must make a \$125 payment)
 - o Not turn in less than your initial disbursement upon settlement of your order

Prizes

- **Sell 20 and get a Keep Calm and Scout On draw string bag and a River Cats game ticket**

 - o Bag may be picked up at the Sacramento Service Center or at your district's May or June meeting.
 - o In some cases, your district executive may deliver bag to a Pack or Troop meeting
- **Weekly Free Camp drawings**
 - o Camp Master or parent may enter name, address, phone number and e-mail address on the Golden Empire Council website by clicking on the "I Sold 20" link : <http://gec-bsa.doubleknot.com/event/i-sold-20-camp-card-promotion/1887615> (you do not have to enter the name twice)
 - o Drawings will be held each Monday at 9am starting March 16 and ending May 4
 - o Free Camp certificate will be delivered to the Scout
 - o Certificate must be used in 2020 at a Golden Empire Council operated camp and is non-transferable
 - o Cub Scouts may choose between Day/Twilight Camp or Resident Camp (resident camp will include one adult)
 - o Boy Scout will be able to choose between the 2 Golden Empire Council Boy Scout Camps (Lassen or Winton)
 - o You only need to register once to be included in all subsequent drawings

- **Above and Beyond Prizes**

- Every Cub Scout can choose only 1 prize, based on the number of cards sold, from the list below:
 - Day/Twilight Camp (100 cards)
 - Cub Resident Camp with adult (250 cards)
 - iPod Touch (500 cards)
 - iPad Air (1,000 cards)
- Every Boy Scout can choose only 1 prize, based on the number of cards sold, from the list below:
 - Boy Scout Resident Camp (250 cards)
 - iPod Touch (500 cards)
 - iPad Air (1,000 cards)
- Prizes are in addition to the commission earned based on the cards sold
- Prizes are non-transferable, have no cash value and may only be redeemed at a Golden Empire Council operated camp in 2020
- Prize forms are available to download at <http://www.gec-bsa.org/promotions/campcards>; these must be submitted at the time you settle your account but no later than May 22nd

Settlement of Your Account

- Payment is due by May 22nd and may be settled at the Sacramento Service Center or with your District Executive by appointment
- You must pay \$2.50 for each unreturned card
- You may return any unsold cards in new condition (must have all 4 break-off tabs still attached)
- No cards will be accepted for return after May 22nd

How Should We Spend Our Commission?

- Your Scouting Unit may choose to spend your commission any way your committee decides; however, our recommendation is to use your commission to offset the cost of camp for your families
