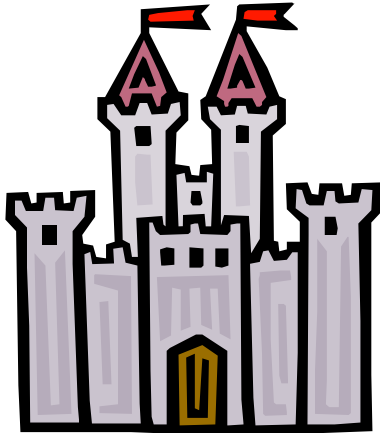


Twilight Camp
