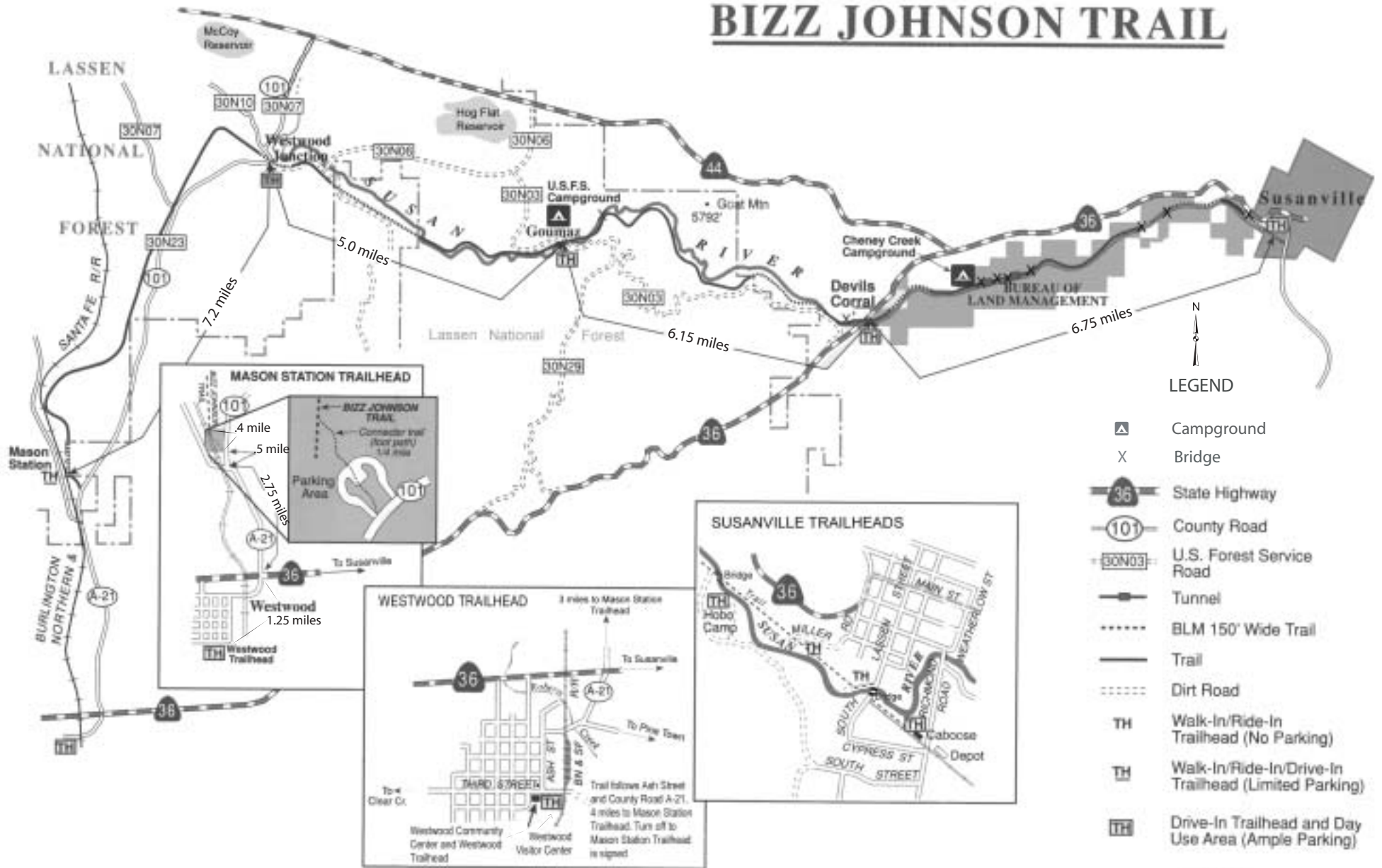
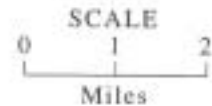


BIZZ JOHNSON TRAIL
