

Merit Badge Clinic Guidelines

Resources: The merit badge pamphlet for the skill being being taught.
Please try and have the most recent merit badge pamphlet available to help answer each requirement.

Use the internet to search for the merit badge being taught. As an example search for citizenship in the community merit badge and then select – Citizenship in the Community-MeritBadgeDotOrg. All requirements will be listed and a worksheet can be printed and used to complete each of your requirements.

Each scout will bring a blue card with the scout's information completed and signed by his scout master stating the scout is qualified to begin working on the merit badge being taught.

The goal of the merit badge session is to be able to sign off a completed merit badge card for each scout attending. This will be accomplished by the scout completing a number of prerequisites and the remainder of the requirements being taught at the clinic.

Each scout will have his prerequisites reviewed and if the prerequisites meet the standards located in the merit badge pamphlet then they will be signed off on his blue card.

The remainder of the merit badge requirements will be taught by the merit badge counselors volunteering for the merit badge being taught.

As a scout you will be responsible for preparing yourself for this and any other merit badges you might take at future clinics. This will include wearing your Class-A scout uniform. Please bring pencils/pens, notebook or paper, and a snack and/or drink.

Prerequisite Requirements will be listed on the Yearly Schedule. All remaining requirements will be taught at the clinic.
