Things that you will need.

The Ingredients for the activities we will be doing during the Den Meeting, making "Slime" & Washing Hands:

For Making "Slime":

- ½ cup. Elmer's white glue
- ½ cup Warm water
- ½ tsp. Baking soda
- 1-3 Tbsp. Saline solution (Contact Lens Solution for Sensitive Eyes)
- Optional: Food coloring
- Air tight container to store the "Slime".

For Hand Washing:

- Glitter
- Paper Towels
- Soap & water

Help your Scout will need from Mom or Dad (including guardians)

- **All Scouts** - Help while making "Slime". This activity involves measuring, mixing, and handling materials in accordance with a recipe. An Adult's participation and supervision will be needed.
- **Tiger Scouts** - Show Mom or Dad how you would wash your hands and explain why it is important to do this before and after a meal. Have Mom or Dad sign off "Tiger Bites" Adventure #2 when you have done this.
- **Wolf Scouts** - Play Germ Magnet with your family. Get "Germs Alive" Adventure, Requirement #2 signed off in your Workbook or Handbook by Mom or Dad.

- **Wolf Scouts** - Observe the Scout as they wash their hands and sing, then sign of their Workbook or Handbooks "Germs Alive" Adventure, Requirement #1
- **Wolf Scouts** - The "Germs Alive" Adventure, Requirement #4 "Mucus Demonstration" was done during tonight's Den Meeting, ask Mon or Dad to sign it off in your Workbook or Handbook.
- **Wolf Scouts** - You have completed "Call of the Wild" Adventure's Requirement 4B Have Mom or Dad sign it off in your Workbook or Handbook.
