Meet the ADVENTURE Leader

Things you will need:

LION – Sign off – **Ready, Set Grow #1 Garden Expert #2 – Where our food comes from (Done during Online Adventure. To complete, plant a container garden #3 (you could use the kitchen scrap garden ideas from our Online Adventure as a starting point) <https://vimeo.com/454167067> video about this Adventure**

TIGER – Sign off **My Tiger Jungle (Required Adventure) #1 – Two sights or sounds, #3 – Learn more about two different kinds of birds that live in your area and #3 – point out and learn more about two birds that live in your area (Done during Online Adventure) See Tiger Book pg. 45-55 (Complete at home by doing ONE more - #2, #4, or #5)**

Sign off **Tigers in the Wild (Required Adventure) #7 – Visit a nature center or zoo and learn about two animals. Write down two interesting things in your Tiger Book. (Done during Online Adventure) To complete this Adventure, you will need to do #1, #2 and #3 – (We will be doing these in May) See Tiger Book pg. 93 – 107.**

WOLF – Sign off **Paws on the Path (Required Adventure) #6 Name two birds, two insects and two other animals that live in your area and explain how to identify them. (Done during Online Adventure) We will be completing this Adventure in May. See Wolf Book page 77 – 91.**

Sign off **Grow Something Elective #2 – Growing Zone for our area and #3 – Visit a Community Garden or Research area and learn about two of the plants that grow there. (Done during Online Adventure) To complete this Adventure, do Grow Something Elective #1 – Plant a seed, care for it for 30 days and take a picture each week to share and #4A, B or C. (You could use the idea from our Online Adventure to grow a sweet potato vine) See Wolf Book page 234 -245.**

BEAR – Sign off **Bear Fur, Feathers and Fern (Required Adventure) #2 – Visit a zoo, nature center, local conservation area, #3 – Name an extinct animal and one that is currently endangered and what causes these declines, and #6 – Learn about composting and how vegetable waste can be used as fertilizer (Done During Online Adventure) To complete this Required Adventure, do #1 – One mile hike or walk and identify signs of mammals, birds, insects, reptiles or plants living there. See Bear Book age 87- 105.**

Sign off **Bear Critter Care #3B – Learn about careers that involve the care of animals. What education, training, and experience are required? (Done during Online Adventure) To complete, you must also do Critter Care #1 and #2. See Bear Book pg. 165 – 174.**

WEBELOS/ARROW OF LIGHT- Sign off **Webelos/Arrow of Light Elective Into the Wild # 4 – Learn about bird**

flyways close to your home and which birds use them, #6 – Identify an insect, reptile, bird or other wild animal that is found only in your area of the country and tell why it survives here, and #9 – visit a museum of natural history, a nature center or a zoo and tell what you saw. (Done During Online Adventure – To complete this Elective, do any Three items from #1, #2, #3, #5, #7 and #8. See Webelos Book pg. 395 – 417.
