



Good Turn For America

All volunteer service hours, including Eagle Scout Project service hours, need to be reported by each BSA unit.

Reporting of service hours is done by someone in your unit using the following directions.

1. Obtain a **"Unit ID"** from your District Executive or by calling the Council Office (800-427-1417). He will provide you with the "Unit ID" necessary to create a username & password.
You only have to do this once to get started. This "Unit ID" is usually the same as the one used to manage **"Internet Advancement"** so your Unit Advancement person should do this.

 3. On left menu select "Tell Us About Your Project"

 5. **Already registered:**
Fill in the blanks (username & password).
Register your hours here and you are done.
 6. **New user:**
 - a. click on **"Create a User Name & Password [Click Here.](#)"**
 - b. Agree to the statement on that page.
 - c. Fill in the form with the information you obtained from your District Executive or by calling the Council Office (800-427-1417).
 - d. Now you can register the service hours.

It is important to BSA that service to our communities be counted so America will know the impact the Boy Scouts have. This will be beneficial to the efforts of BSA officials in obtaining support for various programs.

We have had questions about what kind of service hours apply. The hours should be sponsored by the Scout's unit. But, if the unit is giving the Scouts credit for the service within their unit, then the hours can be recorded on the Good Turn for America site. The unit has to decide whether to count the hours or not.
